### NOC PROGRAMS

#### Urban Rangers

The picture above was a recent Ranger fishing trip. Lots of fun and some good eating as well. Urban Rangers is our discipleship program for 3rd-12th grade boys, modeled after the Boy Scouts, with an urban twist and an added focus on spiritual development. Starts again in September.

#### Thrift Store

Volunteer at our Thrift Store. Consider donating a few hours each week, Mon-Fri 10:00am – 2pm. The store is located on the first floor of our building and it provides quality clothing, home furnishings, and much more, at an affordable price for the surrounding community

#### Local Food Pantry

Due to the extreme poverty level, the vast amount of people without food, and the lack of available resources in our area, we have a food pantry which is opened the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of every month.

#### Elementary After School Program

Once our facility is completed, we anticipate reforming the after-school program in partnership with Youth Life and extending this service to more elementary children living in the HP community.

#### Jobs For Life

JFL is a 5 week, Christ centered job readiness program that address the impact of joblessness through the dignity of work. We commit to applying biblically-based training and mentoring relationships so those in need find dignity and purpose through meaningful work.
